NMD and CMD now fully qualified for distribution into naval projects

DNV has completed the marine and naval testing program of the newly released Hatteland Display Naval Multi Display (NMD) family, which includes the Combat Management Display (CMD) variation. With all tests passed, these specialist products are set to offer new levels of quality and value for demanding C4I applications.

"We are delighted to state that the NMD and CMD are now completely qualified following an extremely rigorous testing period at DNV," comments Brede Qvigstad, Director - Naval & Defence, Hatteland Display AS. "NMD products have already been chosen for several US Naval programs such as DDG-1000, LHA-6, LSD midlife upgrade and Minehunter, so we are now eager to start delivery."

In addition to meeting various maritime type approvals, the NMD and CMD now meet the requirements of MIL-S-901D, Grade A, Class I shock, eliminating the need for shock isolation in the rack or console, as well as Mil-Std-167-1, Mil-Std-461E, and Mil-Std-810F (including salt fog testing).

The new NMD incorporates a high-contrast UXGA resolution liquid crystal display and has been designed as a drop in replacement for existing displays. It can operate in mission critical environments and has the capability to function before, during and after the extreme stress of a combat situation. It also provides optional AC or DC, touch screen and flicker compensation.
